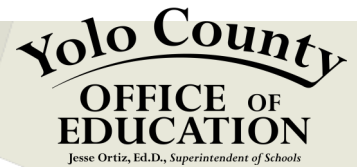

During her 35 year career in education, she has been a middle and high school teacher, technology coordinator, and school administrator. Sue Beers is currently the Director of the Mid-Iowa School Improvement Consortium, which serves over 160 school districts in Iowa. Sue has worked with over 400 school districts in the areas of secondary reading strategies, effective teaching, 21st century learning, curriculum mapping, instructional coaching, student assessment and school improvement.

Institute Description: New standards that lead students to be college and career ready call for new tests that measure that readiness. The Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC) tests were specifically designed to assess the CCR standards and provide information about student learning needs and how instruction might change to meet those needs. In this workshop, participants will examine;

- ◆ What the SBAC results mean in terms of student readiness for college and careers
- ◆ How key documents can inform instruction and provide direction for instructional change
- ◆ How to talk to students and parents about the test results in order to continue to focus on student growth
- ◆ The difference between a growth mindset and proficiency
- ◆ Design elements of the tests and how those elements might affect how instruction is delivered
