



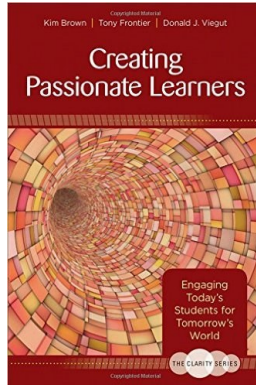

What is authentic student engagement and how is that different from compliance? Engagement literacy provides educators with a shared language of different types of student engagement—from rebellion and retreatism to passive compliance, ritualistic engagement and authentic engagement—in order to understand how to best support students’ investment (or lack of investment) in their schooling experience. Participants will learn specific strategies to build students’ cognitive engagement, how to create safe space to support emotional engagement, and establish meaningful routines and tasks to build behavioral engagement in each classroom.
